

YAH'S SET APART "SABBATH"

YHWH a sign between **YHWH** and the children of Israel forever; for in (6) six days **Elohim (YHWH)** made the heavens and the earth, then rested he on the (7) Seventh day. **Exodus 31:17**

YHWH blessed and set apart the (7) Seventh day, and in it He rested from all His works. The Sabbath was the day after the creation of the first human (6), which is an ordained time for man to focus on Worshiping **YHWH**, building a close personal relationship with his Maker. **Genesis 2:2-3**

When we exercise proper respect and appreciation for this Set apart day, we also honor **YHWH** by acknowledging His authority over our lives. This also declares **Yahushua** is **Elohim (GOD)** of the Sabbath, thereby forever linking the Creator with this holy time. **Yahushua** said to them, "The Sabbath was made for **MAN**, and not man for the Sabbath, for this reason the Son of Man (**Yahushua**) is **YHWH (GOD)** of the "Sabbath" and has authority over the day of worship." **Mark 2:27-28**.

YHWH gave instructions concerning the observance of the Sabbath in **Exodus 20:8** when he gave the **4th** of the **10 commandments**. Man is to "Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it Separated or Set apart (**NOT HOLY**)."
It is to be kept Set apart as a reminder to those called of **YAH**, that He is the (**1**) One who sets them apart and that they are the children of **YAH (CHOSEN)**.

MANkind remembers and follows the Sabbath by worshiping and resting on the (7) seventh day. As true believers following this pattern, they are following the example of their Creator and are reminded of the one who created them.

he Sabbath is a sign between **YAH** and His people (Chosen) and constitutes a perpetual COVENANT, and is the only Commandment in which contains **YAH's "Seal"** or "**MARK**". **Exodus 31:13-17**

YAHWEH is the only one who can make anything Set apart. **MAN**kind can dedicate special time to **YAH**, but **YAH** alone can set time aside as Separated unto himself and his **CHOSEN** people (**JEW & CHOSEN Gentile**).
