

YHWH'S SET APART FEAST DAYS

These are **YHWH's** appointed feasts, the sacred assemblies you are to proclaim at their appointed times ... **Leviticus 23**

The Word of **YHWH** lists (7) Seven festivals to be celebrated each year.

The first is the Passover, a memorial of the sacrifice of **Yahushua** for our **sins**. This is also when we renew our agreement to come under the **blood** of **Yahushua**, the perfect Passover Lamb for the forgiveness of our **SINS**. (THIS IS NOT EASTER, the **Man** made PAGAN holiday of **JESUS**, that began by PAGAN's, worshipping the **GOD** of EASTRE, the **God**dess of fertility, i.e...the bunny rabbits and eggs.

In the Torah (the (5) first five books of Moses), there are (7) seven set apart festivals instituted by **YHWH**:

The Feast of Passover (Pesach) - celebrated the night when the angel passed over the Hebrew households in Egypt. Along with **Yahushua** freely giving his Set apart **Blood** as the Sacrifice to cover **SIN** forever.

The Feast of Unleavened Bread- commemorated the first 7 days of the Exodus when the Hebrews left Egypt in such a hurry that they did not have time to add yeast to their dough. (Communion, Due this in remembrance Him and his sacrifice of his Flesh (his Body) and his **shed Blood (LIFE)**).

The Day of First Fruits (The Omer) the **17th day of Nisan**, was a celebration of the harvest, when a sheaf representing the very first of the harvest was waved before **YHWH** as a symbolic gesture that dedicated the coming harvest to Him.

Yahushua rose from the dead on the **Feast of First-fruits**. His resurrection was like a wave offering presented to the Father as the first-fruits of the harvest to come at the end of the age.

The Feast of Weeks - also called the Pentecost (**Shavuot**). It marked the end of the harvest and offering of first fruits. (**Yahushua** was the **FIRST** fruit, and the Spirit of **YHWH** was given to **MAN**kind).

The Feast of Trumpets (Yom Teruah) - the blowing of a ram's horn, or

shofar, to call the people to prepare for the Day of Atonement (**Yom Kippur**). Later this day became the Jewish New Year (**Rosh Hashanah**).

When the sound of the Trumpets blows from Heaven, we know our Savior is on his way back to get his bride

The Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur) - the most solemn day of the year. On this day, the High Priest sacrificed **Sin** offerings to atone all the sins of the people and entered the Most Set apart Place to offer incense.

The Feast of Tabernacles (Sukkot) - celebrated the completion of the great fall harvest and remembered the Hebrews in the Exodus living in tents for **40 years**.

The (7) seven annual days are annual Sabbaths; they are set apart occasions and commanded assemblies of **YHWH 's** people (JEW and CHOSEN Gentile). These days are Set apart by **YHWH**.

YAH commands His people to assemble for worship and to learn about Him and His plan. His command goes further than worship only; it includes fellowship, rejoicing and Praise **together** in **YAH 's** NAME. **Leviticus 23:1-4; Deuteronomy 14:23-26; Nehemiah 8:1-12**

Sadly, most who profess to be **Christians** today do not observe **YAH 's** Sacred festivals, typically calling them "Jewish" feasts and claiming they are obsolete. Yet celebrating the **MAN** made Pagan Holiday's of **Easter** and **Christmas** tagging them to **JESUS**, supposedly HE is the reason for the season and he is since **JESUS** and **SANTA CLAUS** were created around the same time.

YAH said these are His feasts and He commands that they shall be observed, even in the New Testament. **YAH** defined these celebrations as His festivals, or "the feasts of **YHWH**" **Leviticus 23:2-4**.

Because believers do not observe these Set apart festivals as **YAH** commands, they do not understand their meaning and how they are for a Set apart purpose to reveal the coming of the MESSIAH:

- 1. Passover** (Lamb of **YHWH**, shedding of his sinless blood for the remission of SIN)
- 2. Feasts of Unleavened Bread** (representing SIN and Sacred

Communion)

3. The Day of First Fruits (The Omer) **Yahushua** rose from the dead on the Feast of First-fruits.

4. Pentecost (time when **YAH** gave **MAN**kind his Spirit)

5. Feast of Trumpets (Blowing of the trumpet/ shofar) announcing the return of **Yahushua** to gather his Chosen (**Rapture**).

6. The Day of Atonement (**Yahushua's 2nd** coming as our High Priest, our Messiah)

7. The Feast of Tabernacles (Represents the millennial reign of **Yahushua** and is a time of celebration and rejoicing in **YAHWEH** for all Nations)

Obeying **YAH 's** commands and observing his Set apart days, gives believers a better understanding. The fear of **YAHWEH** is the **beginning** of **wisdom**; all who follow his precepts have good understanding.
